Dr. Greene has a private practice in Los Gatos, where he treats patients with mental illness and performs evaluations for civil and criminal legal questions dealing with mental illness. He is on the Adjunct Clinical Faculty at Stanford, where he teaches forensic psychiatry to residents in training. Dr. Greene regularly give talks to agencies around the Bay Area, including the Santa Clara and Santa Cruz County Offices of the Public Defender, and the San Jose Police.
